ANA BASE SECURITY UPGRADES

POL E CHARKI, AFGHANISTAN



AFGHAN NATIONAL ARMY (ANA) BASE POL E CHARKI WAS DILAPIDATED AND UNSECURE. ACM WORLDWIDE WAS CONTRACTED TO REPLACE AND UPGRADE ALL ACCESS SECURITY BARRIERS/GATES AS WELL AS PROVIDE ADVANCED BOX CULVERTS TO CHANNEL AND PROTECT A WADI (SEASONAL RIVERBED) THAT FLOWS THROUGH THE BASE. ADDITIONALLY, ACM BUILT AN OVERFLOW/FLOW THROUGH BRIDGE OVER THE WADI.

IN UNDER 180 DAYS, ACM UPGRADED ALL SECURITY GATES, BUILT SIX GUARD TOWERS, CONSTRUCTED TROOP LIVING QUARTERS, GUARD HOUSES AND FIGHTING POSITIONS. 4000 METERS OF FENCING, WITH SNIPER SCREEN, WAS ALSO CONSTRUCTED ON TOP OF AN EXISTING 3 METER PERIMETER WALL. ACM'S INNOVATIVE APPROACH ENSURED COMPLETE BASE SECURITY DURING THE COURSE OF CONSTRUCTION.
