ROUTES YANKEE AND UTAH BAGHDAD, IRAQ



THIS UNDERTAKING NOT ONLY ENCOMPASSED ROADS THAT WERE HEAVILY DAMAGED WITH MORTAR AND IED CRATERS, BUT ALSO REQUIRED A MUCH HIGHER SECURITY PRESENCE DUE TO THEIR LOCATION. THE CONSTRUCTION TEAMS HAULED EVERY PIECE OF HEAVY EQUIPMENT TO AND FROM THE SITE ON A DAILY BASIS TO ENSURE BOTH SAFETY AND SECURITY OF THEIR EQUIPMENT AND PERSONNEL. ACM WORLDWIDE WORKED WITH THE LOCAL COMMUNITIES TO PROVIDE OVER 500 JOBS DURING THE COURSE OF CONSTRUCTION, THUS ENHANCING THE SAFETY OF THE PROJECT BY WORKING TOGETHER WITH LOCAL VILLAGES. ACM WORLDWIDE COMPLETED THIS \$3.5M PROJECT TWO WEEKS AHEAD OF SCHEDULE.
